Courtesy Practice Rounds: Courtesy Practice Rounds are available. Please call the golf shop for starting time availability. Contestants are limited to **one** courtesy practice round. In view of damage caused by play of extra balls during practice rounds, the USGA asks players not to abuse the courtesy extended by the club in the use of its course. **The USGA requests that each player play only one ball at each hole during the practice round.** During practice rounds, practice on a putting green is permissible, provided play by a following group is not delayed.

Withdrawals: Please advise the NEGA office immediately at (774) 430-9020, if you are unable to compete.

Round 1 Tee Times: Will begin at 7am off the 1st tee & 10th tees.

Round 2 Tee Times: Will begin **30** minutes after the completion of Round 1 on the opposite tee played from Round 1.

Player Shuttle: **A player shuttle will be provided from the PRACTICE AREA to the 10th TEE. Please be ready for the shuttle at least 20 minutes before your starting time.**

Distance Devices: The use of distance measuring devices is *prohibited*. Penalty for breach of this rule: **Disqualification.**

Cellular Telephones: The use of cellular telephones by competitors and/or caddies is prohibited.

Automotive Transportation: Automotive transportation is **not** permitted during the stipulated round.

Golf Balls: The One-Ball Rule will be in effect.

Competition Tees/Yardage: The competition will be played from the **BLACK** tees (Approx. 6,700 yards).

Golf Shop & Practice Facilities: The golf shop and practice facilities will be open at 6:00am.

Food and Beverage Services: Services will be available after competitors complete Round 1.

Dress Code: Please observe the USGA dress code as stated in the U.S. Amateur Championship application.

Round 2: Please be aware that an 18-hole cut may be implemented, based on Round 1 Scores.
