We are pleased to submit the following information for your benefit as a competitor in the 2010 USGA Open Qualifying at Twin Hills Country Club in Longmeadow, MA.

Courtesy Practice Rounds: A courtesy practice round is available. (Please call the golf shop to schedule a tee time and be sure to identify yourself as a competitor). Each competitor is limited to **one** courtesy practice round. Courtesy practice round privileges will be honored only during the aforementioned time and date; requests for alternate times will not be considered. In view of damage caused by play of extra balls during practice rounds, the NEGA asks players not to abuse the courtesy extended by the club in the use of its course. The NEGA and the USGA requests that each player play only one ball at each hole during the practice round.

Withdrawals: Please advise the NEGA office immediately at (774) 430-9020 if you are unable to compete. Failure to advise the NEGA office may disqualify the player from future USGA competition. Distance Devices: The use of distance measuring devices is prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **Disqualification.**

Cellular Telephones: The use of cellular telephones is prohibited.

Golf Ball: The One-Ball Rule will be in effect. See Appendix 1 of the Rules of Golf.

Competition Tees/Yardage: The competition will be played from the **GOLD** tees (Approx. 6,662 yds).

Golf Shop and Practice Range: They will be open and available at 7:00am.

Dress Code: Please observe the USGA dress code as stated in the US Open application.

NEW GROOVE CONDITION OF COMPETITION

**NOT IN EFFECT FOR LOCAL QUALIFYING
IN EFFECT FOR SECTIONAL QUALIFYING AND CHAMPIONSHIP PROPER**

The player's clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010.

*PENALTY FOR CARRYING, BUT NOT MAKING STROKE WITH, CLUB OR CLUBS IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round - Four strokes. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.

*Any club or clubs carried in breach of this condition must be declared out of play by the player to his marker or a fellow-competitor immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. If the player fails to do so, he is disqualified.

PENALTY FOR MAKING STROKE WITH CLUB IN BREACH OF CONDITION: Disqualification.
