

MGA SENIOR FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS & REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to two-person teams of amateur golfers who hold membership at an MGA member club, who have reached their 55th birthday by August 30, 2010 and who have an up-to-date MGA/USGA GHIN combined Handicap Index not exceeding 12.0 (as determined by the July 15, 2010 Handicap Revision) or have completed their handicap certification as defined on the Entry Form. The field is limited to 112 teams. **Entries will be on a first come, first served basis.**

EXEMPTIONS

1) Upon receipt of the Entry Form and fee, the low twenty (20) teams and ties in the 2009 MGA Senior Four-Ball Amateur Championship are entered in the Championship if they are the same team and have a combined Handicap Index not exceeding 12.0.

2) Special exemptions as selected by the MGA.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Teams shall apply on the MGA Entry Form attached. Teams shall apply on the MGA Entry Form attached. Entry fee of \$300.00 shall be paid by every team. Entry fee includes player's luncheon on August 30 at both Championship Sites and cart fees for Championship Proper.

Refund Policy: Entry fee will be refunded, regardless of reason, if the MGA is notified in writing before the close of entries. After the close of entries, regardless of schedule changes, entry fee will be refunded only in the event of injury or illness, and if requested in writing by August 30, 2010, subject to MGA Championship Committee approval. Refunds will be issued, less a \$20.00 service charge, after completion of the Championship. Entry forms must be received by the MGA.

Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entries by telephone, e-mail or fax will not be accepted. Deadline for entry means time of receipt at MGA office - not time of postmark. Entry should be mailed early to allow ample time for delay.

Teams in the Championship will be notified by e-mail of their starting times and availability of practice privileges.

Courtesy practice privileges are at the discretion of the host club(s). Alternate teams for the Championship will be notified of their playing status by the MGA office.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

A team who decides not to participate must notify the MGA office (1-800-356-2201) by phone promptly. Failure to comply may result in a team's entry being rejected from future MGA competition.

SCHEDULE

Competition will be 36 Holes at Four-Ball Stroke Play. The field is limited to 112 teams.

Monday, August 30

First Round, 18 Holes.

Tuesday, August 31

Second Round, 18 Holes.

Any tie for first place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off at The Orchards GC.

RULES OF GOLF

Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA. Questions shall be settled by the Committee in charge of the competition consisting of those officials assigned by the MGA, whose decision shall be final.

CADDIES & AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION

Cart fee is included in entry fee. Pull carts and caddies are permitted.

DRESS CODE

Proper dress code for all stages of the competition will be strictly observed.

CELLULAR TELEPHONES

The use of cellular telephones is prohibited.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES

In this competition, a player may use devices that measure or gauge distance only (see the Note to Rule 14-3). However, the use of a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) is not permitted regardless of whether such an additional function is used.

GOLF SHOE POLICY

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition:

Disqualification.

PRIZES

The James Shea Memorial Trophy will be presented to the Champions. Gold and Silver medals will also be awarded.

INCLEMENT WEATHER/CANCELLED ROUND STIPULATION

If 36 holes of competition cannot be completed as scheduled, the low 18-hole score from each site will be used to determine Co-Champions.

CONDITIONS/SCHEDULES

The MGA Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Executive Committee in any matter shall be final.

PLAYER'S LUNCHEON

The MGA will be providing a complimentary luncheon on August 30th at both Championship sites for all competitors.
